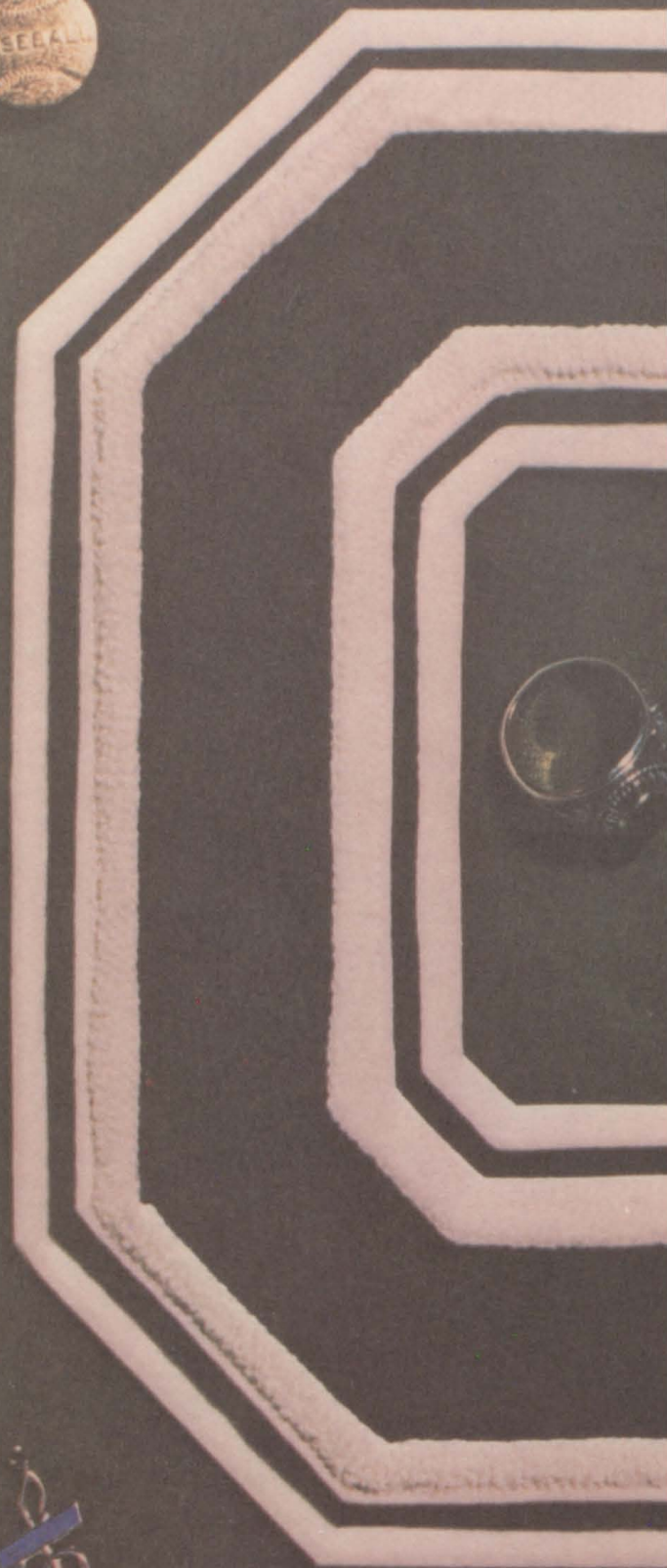

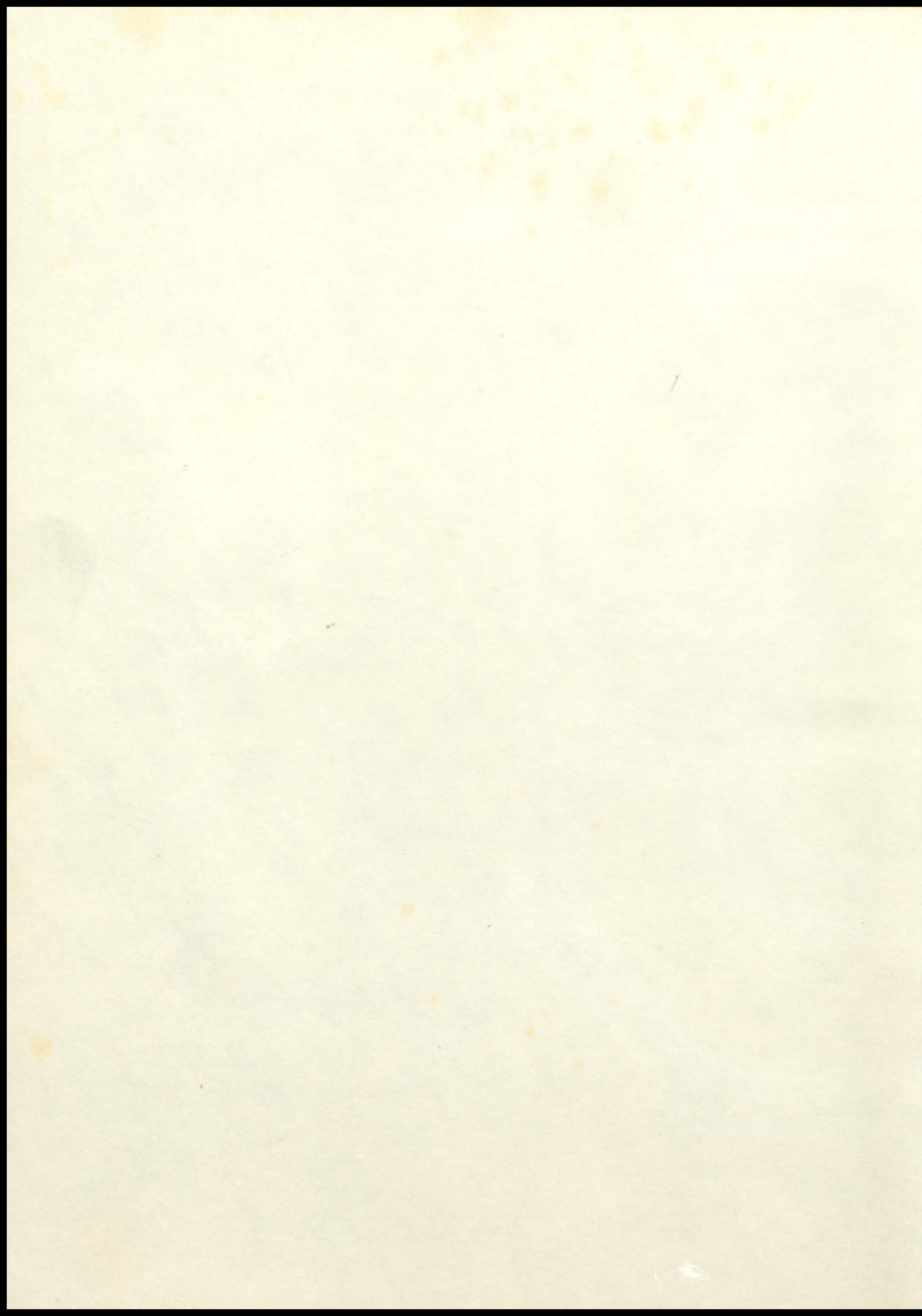

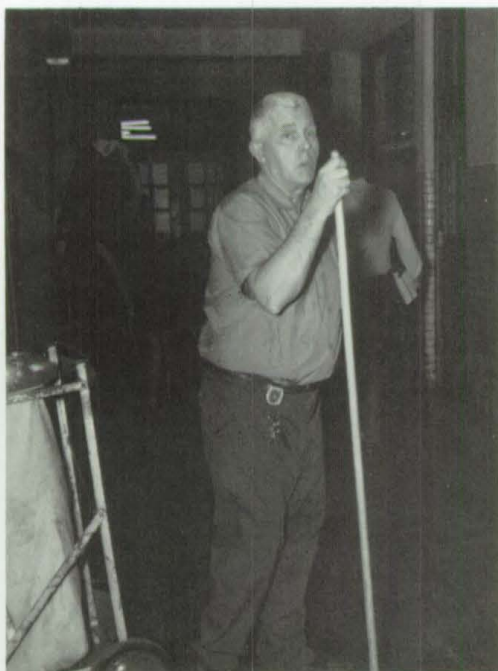
# 1970 DEDICATION
