A WORD FROM THE COACH

It is difficult to describe the 1979 football season. In the pre-season the coaches and players had high expectations for the upcoming season. In the opening game of the season we played poorly; then in the second game at Tipp City we played very well. The third game, against archrival Bradford, was the worst game we had played in two years and ended with 0-0 tie. From that point on our team began to improve each week. The momentum grew until the Versailles game when the Buccs played one of the best defensive games ever played by a Covington football team. Not only did the victory give us a good chance to win the Three Rivers Conference and vault us into the number one spot in the Computer Ratings; it also avenged the 1978 loss to the Tigers. After the Versailles game the team leveled off, playing excellent football and winning the rest of the regular season games. Then came the State semi-final play-offs. The Tiffin Calvert game was the best game of the year for the Buccs. Then on to Akron and the State Finals, where we had a double overtime loss to Mogadore. Even in losing, the team and coaches felt a sense of satisfaction because they knew they had played their best.




A WORD FROM THE COACH

Our record is not indicative of our ability. We just lost many games this year because of our lack of hitting. The overall team average was just .224 and we could only average 2 runs a game. 




A WORD FROM THE COACH


A WORD FROM THE ADVISOR

The National Honor Society is a club for students with outstanding qualities in scholarship, leadership, character and service as determined by their teachers and


their actions in school. The society's main purpose is to give recognition to these students which they might otherwise not receive.
