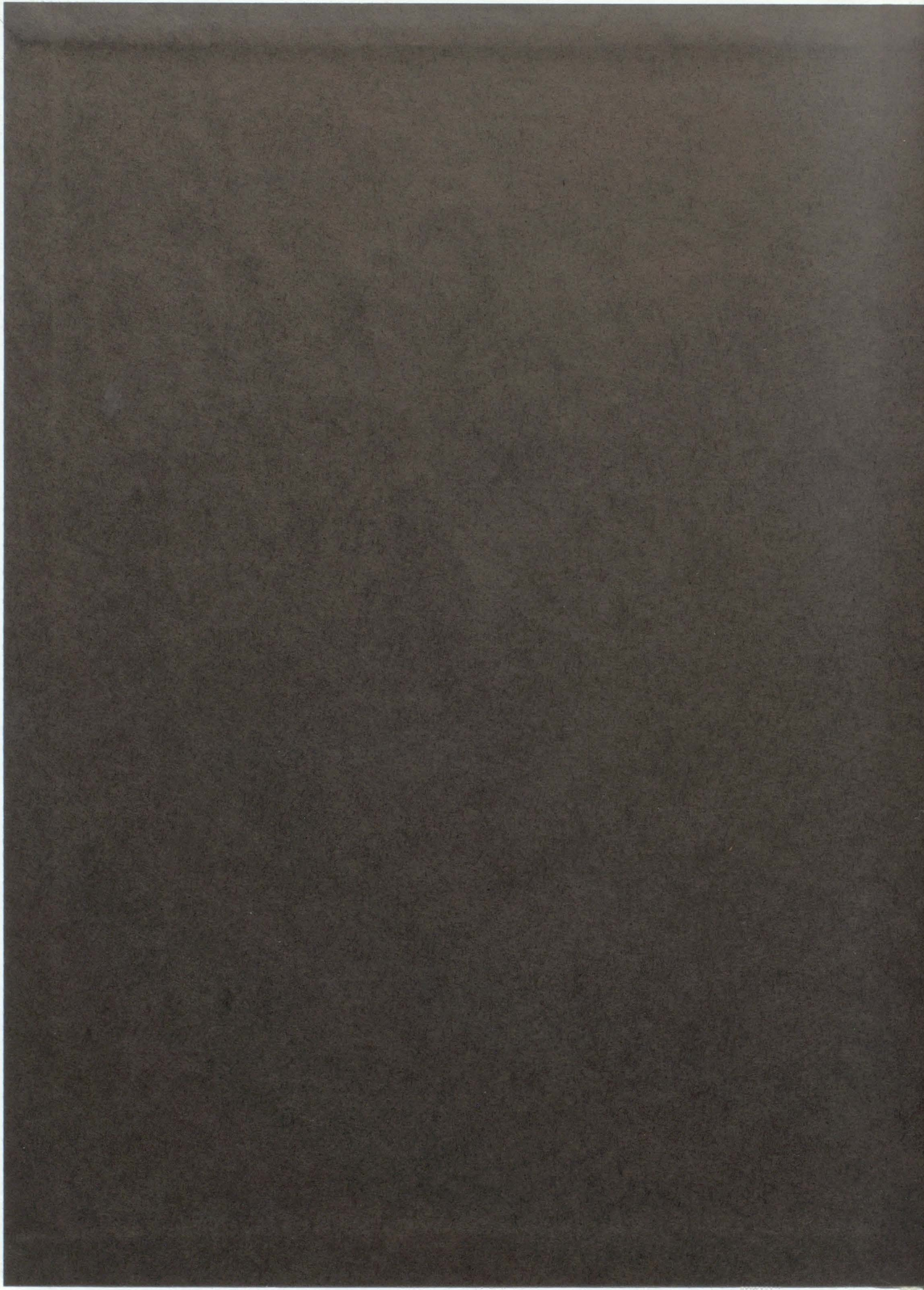

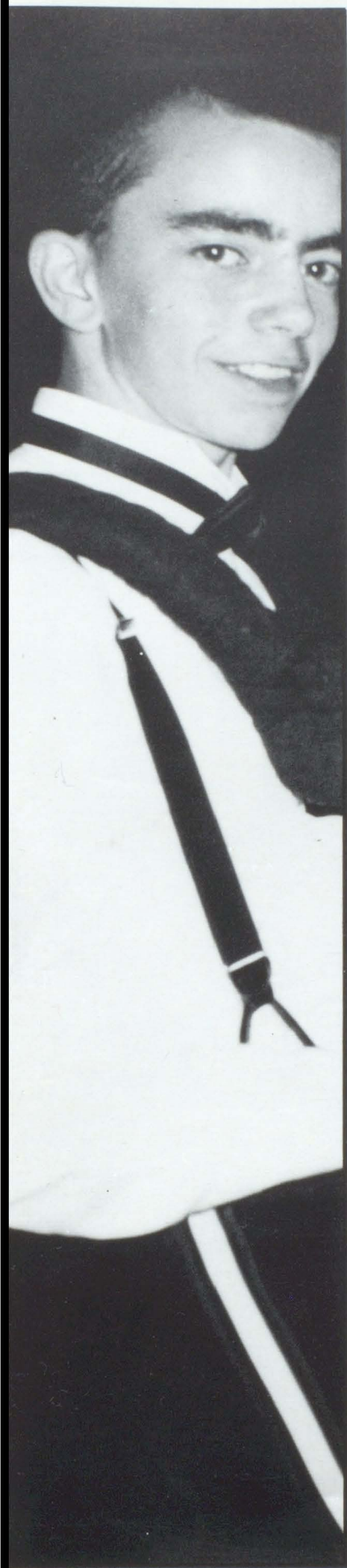

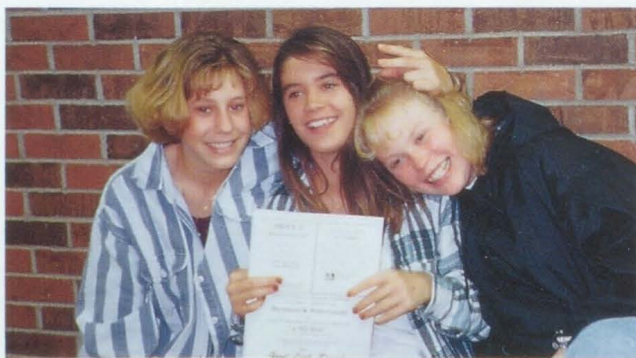

We all used to think it was cool to "hang out" at the bowling alley, yet no one ever used to bowl.











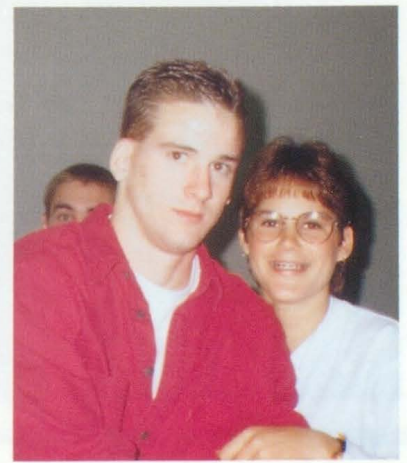
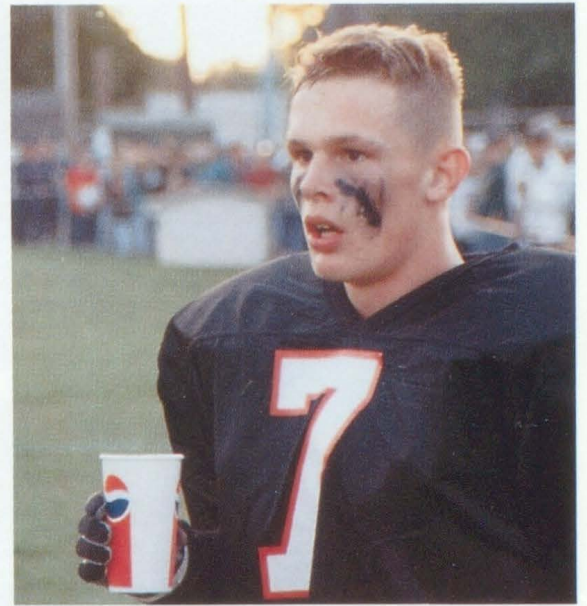

We came to school one snowy day and there was a car on the top of a snow pile.













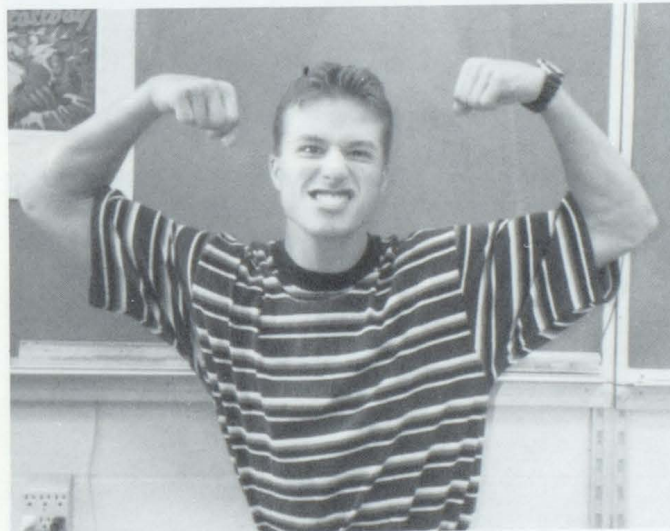

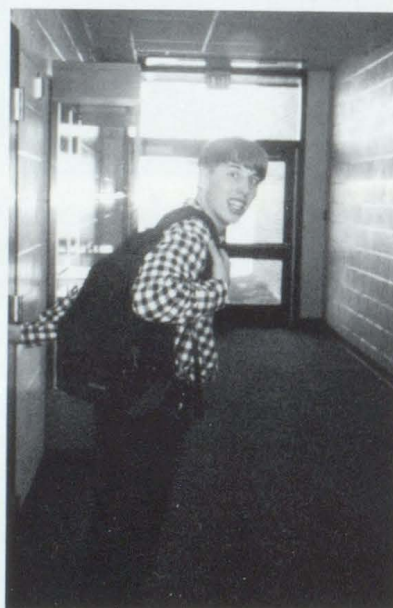
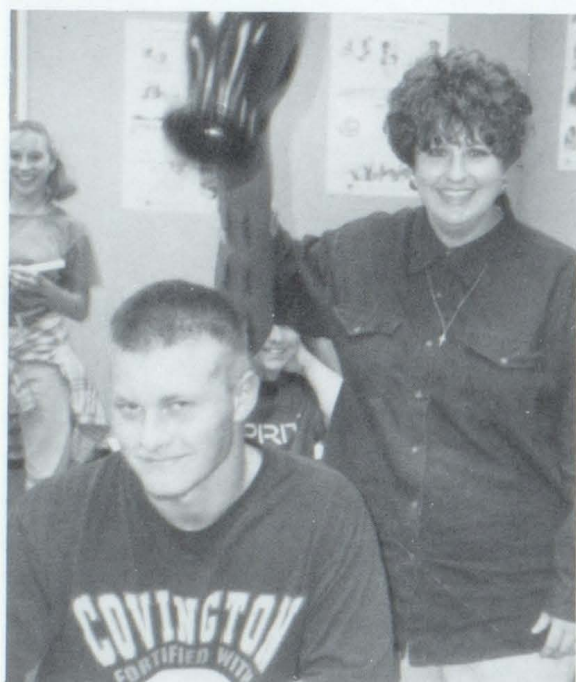
Mollie Huffman tickled Adam Negley while he was hanging on the monkey bars at the elementary playground and he fell and landed on his head.

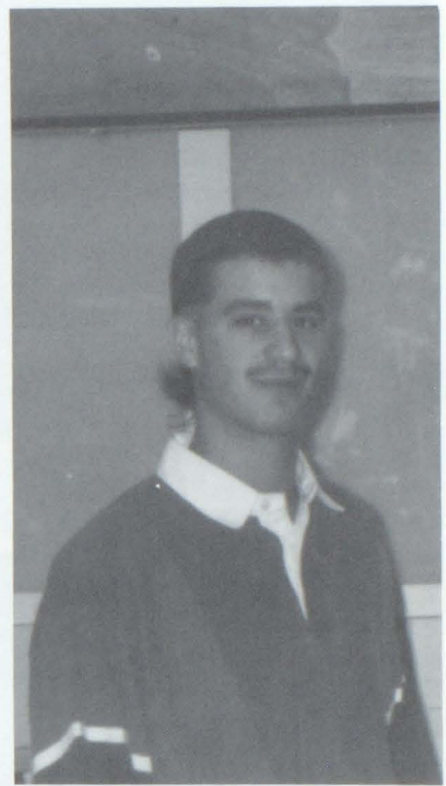
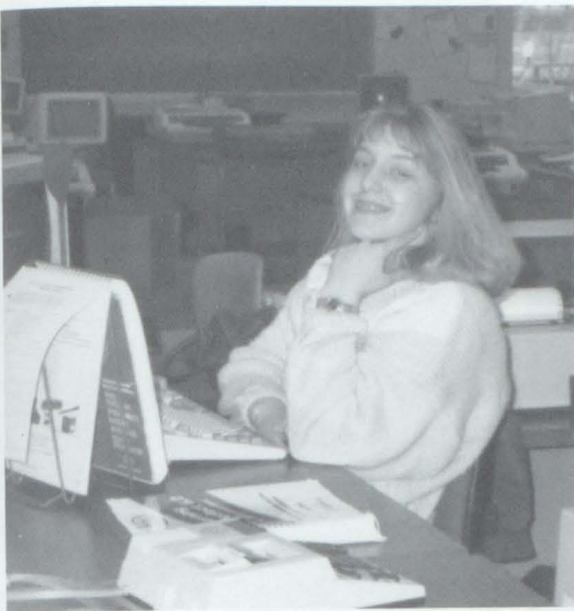


# JVS

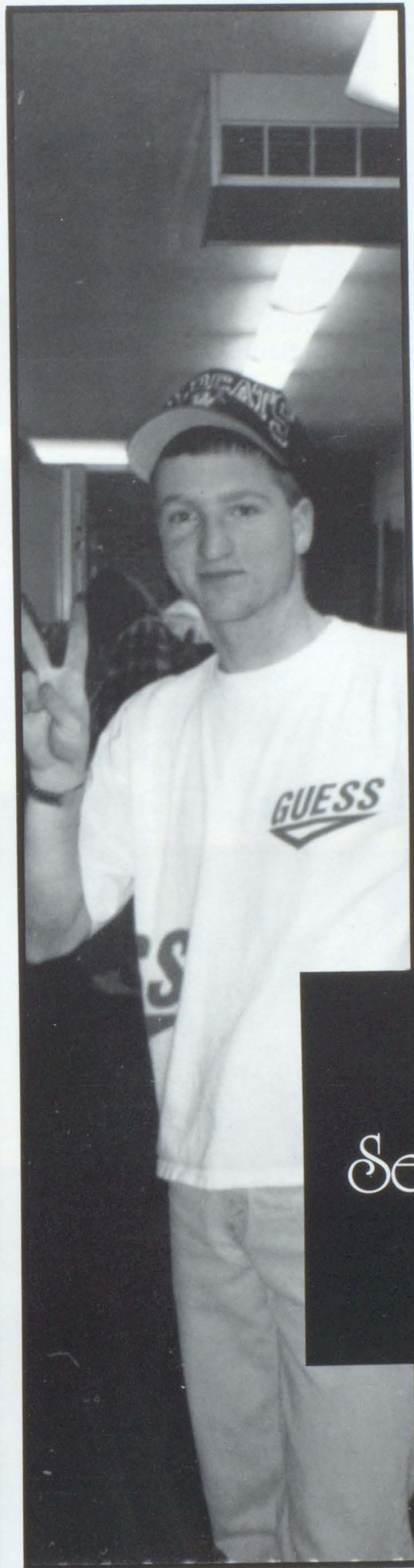

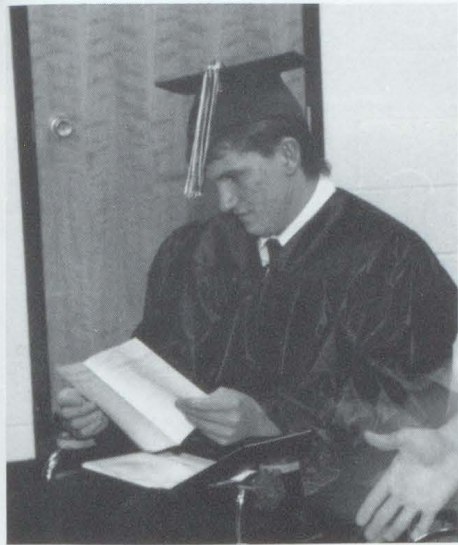
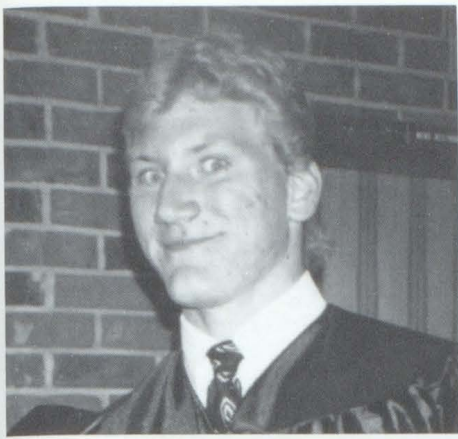


# Graduation

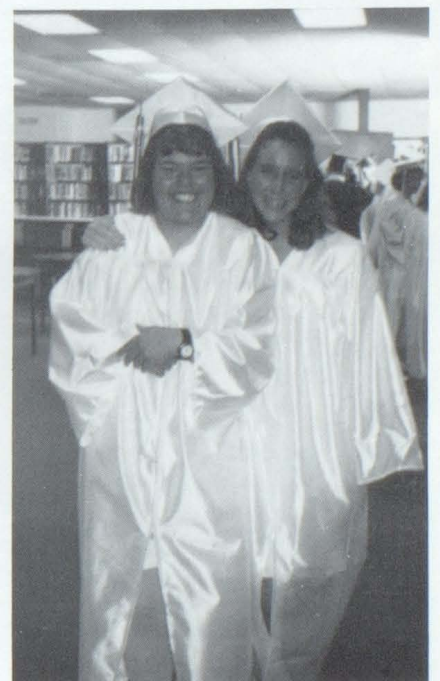
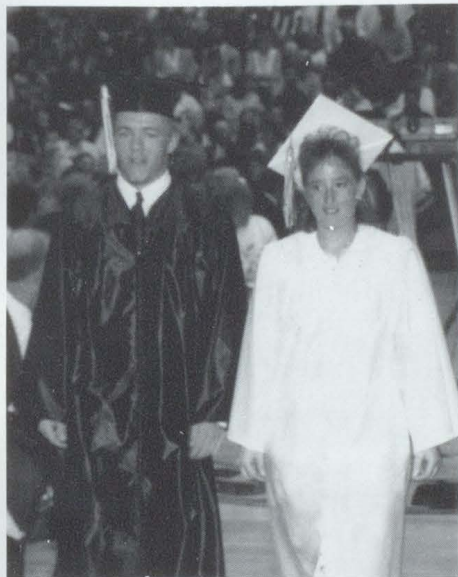
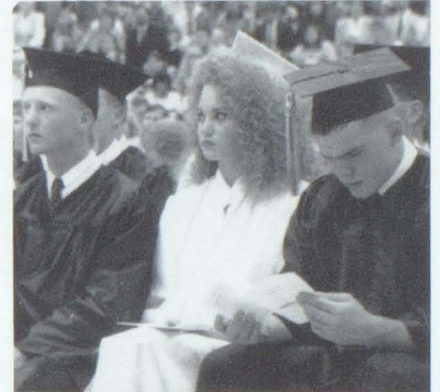


Everyone was quiet

"Look at me, I'm a big boy now!"

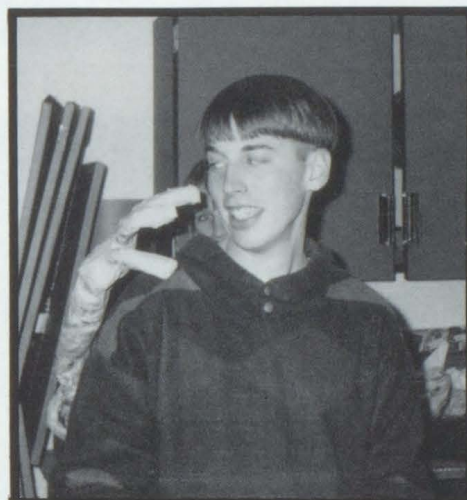
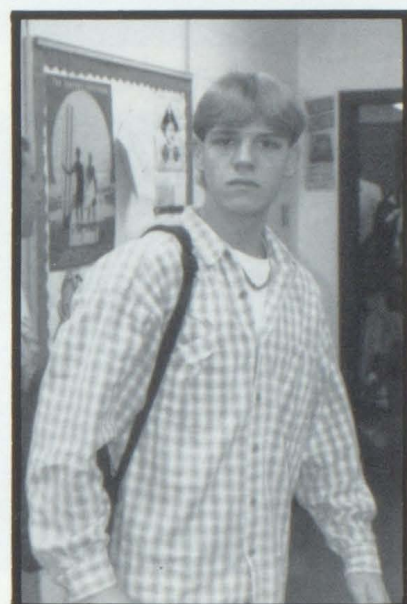
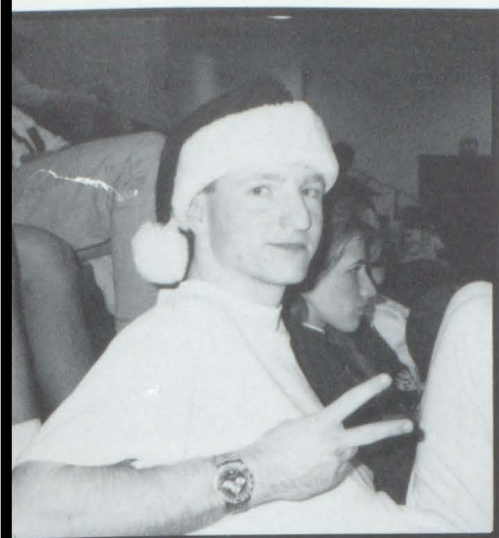

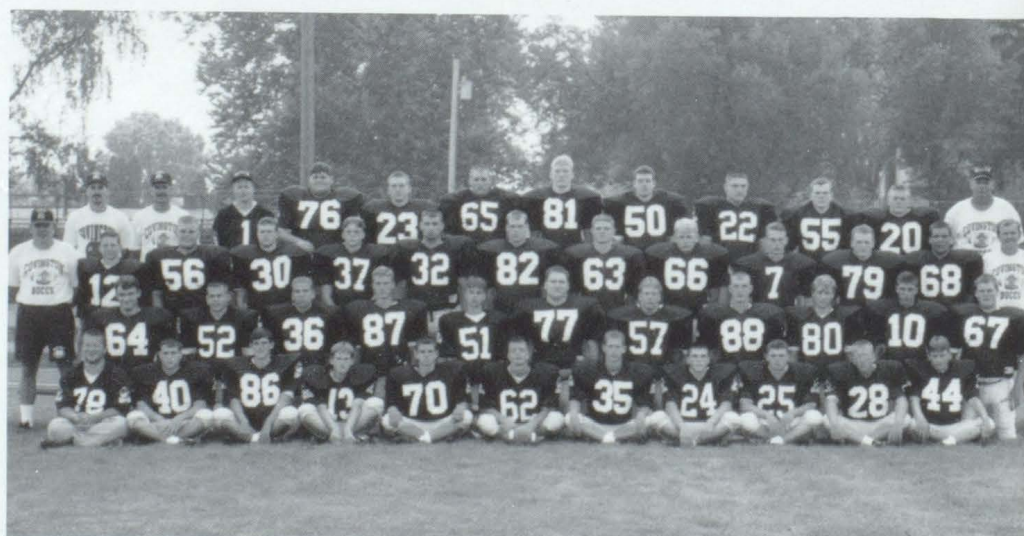
# Football

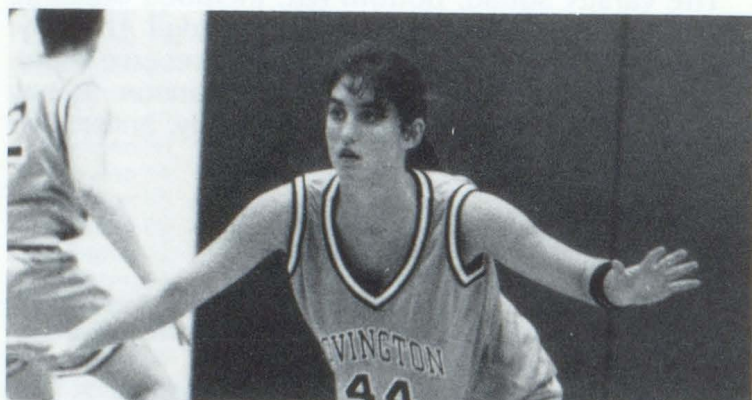




# Girl's Varsity Basketball
