
# CHRISTMAS FUN DAY




# GIRLS' CROSS COUNTRY






# VARSITY BOYS' BASKETBALL

Despite being relatively young, the Covington High School Wrestling team enjoyed a successful season during 2000-2001. 




# GIRLS' TRACK


